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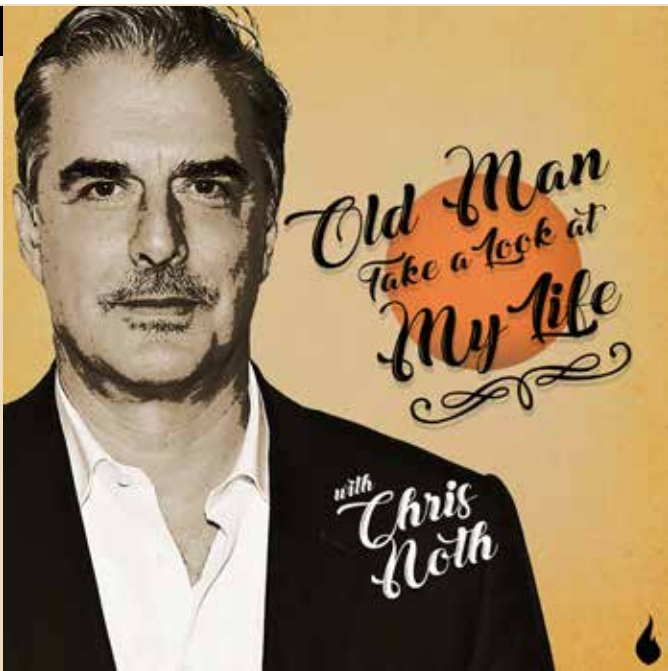

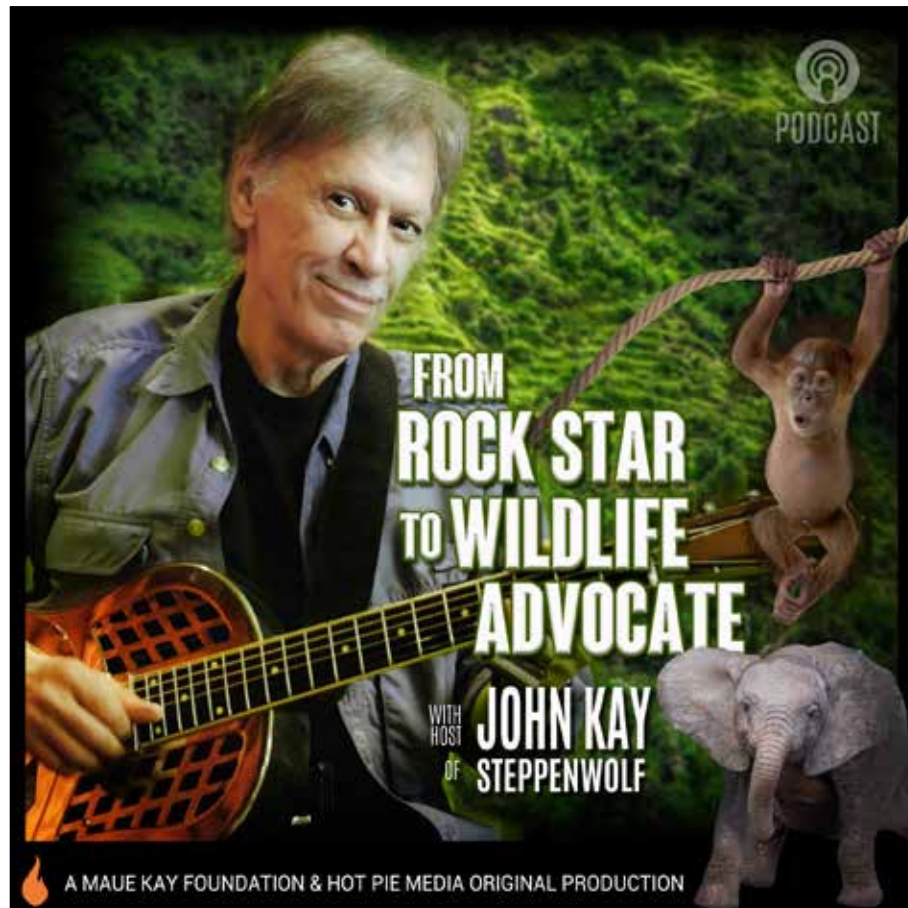

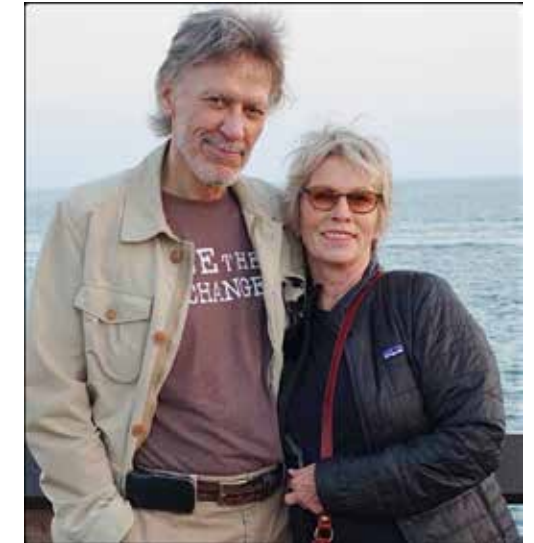

John Kay – Host

Born in East Prussia, Germany at the end of World War II, John Kay grew up trapped behind the iron curtain. His first distinct memory is a daring nighttime escape with his mother to West Germany; where later he was profoundly affected by the American rock 'n' roll he heard on U.S. Armed Forces

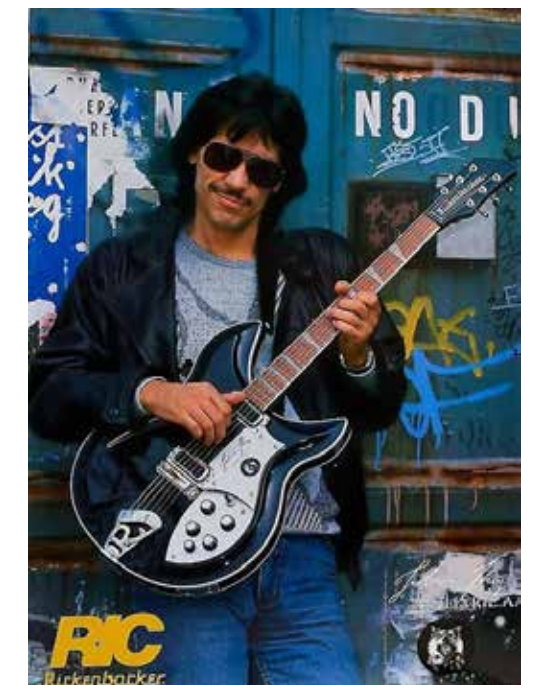
Radio. In 1958, he immigrated to Canada and continued his love affair with music, performing as a folk and blues singer throughout North America. John eventually joined the rock band The Sparrow and played in Toronto's Yorkville, San Francisco's Haight Ashbury and, finally, LA's Sunset Strip. There, in 1967, John formed Steppenwolf. Steppenwolf's impressive discography includes the hits "Born to Be Wild" and "Magic Carpet Ride," songs that catapulted the band into international prominence. Other classics include powerful songs like "The Pusher," "Snow Blind Friend" and "Monster." The band's masterful lyrics led Steppenwolf to earn the nickname, "The thinking man's rock band." As Steppenwolf's vocalist and primary songwriter John's been the band's driving force, always ready to speak his mind, never willing to compromise the band's music. In October 2019, after 50 years of performing, John Kay & Steppenwolf played their final concert. While John still plays occasional acoustic solo shows, he devotes most of his time on behalf of the Maue Kay Foundation, formed in 2004 by John and Jutta Maue-Kay, and its wildlife conservation and human rights projects. Judge has been an active member of the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts and Sciences since 1987.



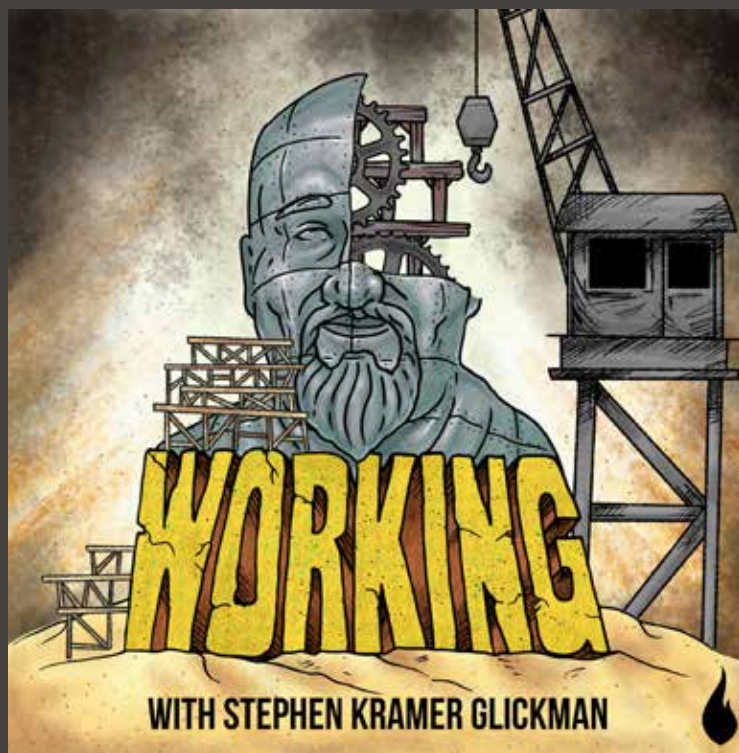

She also was personal manager to Ronnie Wood for the last ten years of her tenure prior to her retirement. Sherry is the Executive Producer on many Rolling Stones' documentaries including; Crossfire Hurricane, Totally Stripped, Stones in Exile, and others. She is credited on all of Charlie Watts's Jazz activities and worked with him in 1985 to set up "The Charlie Watts Orchestra," consisting of more than 30 of the cream of British jazz musicians. The band was inaugurated at Ronnie Scotts in Soho, London, in 1985 and went on to do two tours of America, performing at the Playboy Jazz Festival. Charlie had many iterations of this band over his Jazz career and travelled the world with them, including the Blue Notes in New York and Tokyo, amongst other places. He produced ten albums to celebrate his various lineups. Sherry worked with Ronnie on both his solo music career, his extensive art career and radio broadcasts. Since retirement, Sherry has continued to work with Chris Jagger, a multi-talented musician, writer and traveller and has worked with him to produce an autobiography and album just released by BMG this September.

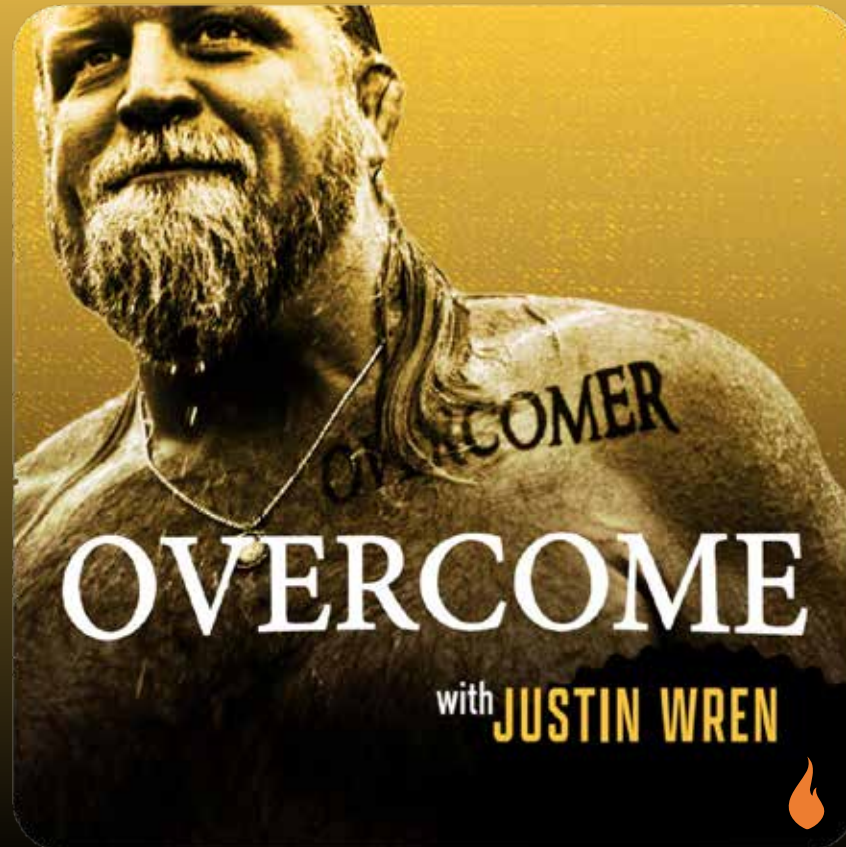


Justin Wren - Host:

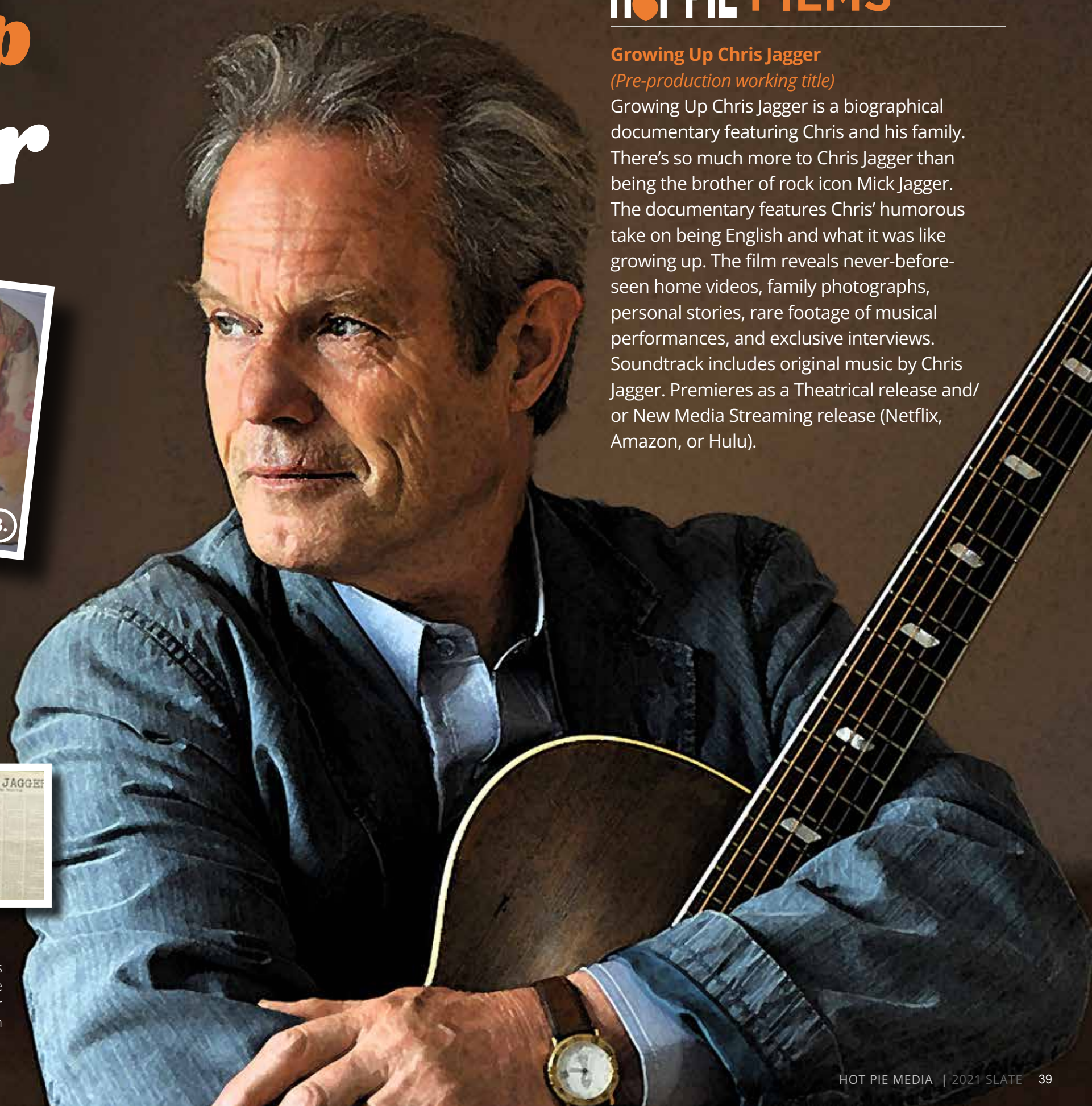
